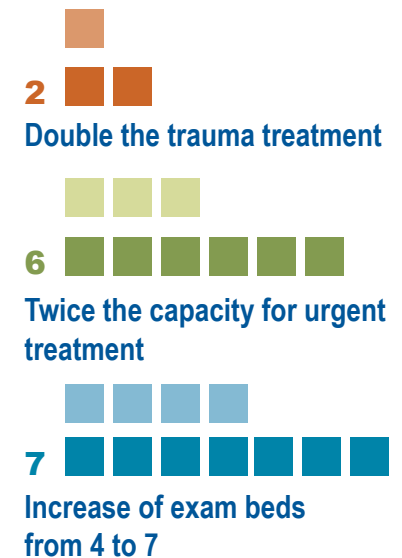

Project construction - a timeline

- 1962** — The original 44-bed FSJ Hospital was constructed
- 2005** — Northern Health embarked on an extensive review of the FSJ Hospital
- April 2008** — Funding approval announced for the FSJ Hospital and Residential Care project, and an RFP was issued in October 2008
- March 2009** — ISL Health was selected as the preferred proponent
- July 22, 2009** — Ground was officially broken at the FSJ Hospital and Residential Care project site
- June 21, 2012** — The FSJ Hospital opened to patients
- June 24, 2012** — Peace Villa opened to patients

Project history - a timeline

- April 22, 2008** — Project announced
- Spring 2008** — City of Fort St. John transfers 40 acres to NH for FSJH/PV
- June 2009** — Groundwork begins
- June 16, 2009** — Financial close and signing of the final project agreement with ISL Health
- May 28, 2011** — FSJH Foundation starts the “Raise Your Hand” campaign to raise \$1.2 million for equipment for the FSJ Hospital and PV
- June 2012** — All \$24 million new equipment needed for FSJH and PV has been bought
- June 8, 2012** — FSJH Foundation reaches \$1.2 Million goal
- July 12, 2012** — Official grand opening

Fort St. John Hospital and Peace Villa are located on Treaty 8 territory, and the the traditional territory of the Tsáá? Ché Ne Dane people, the descendants of the Fort St. John Beaver Band, namely the Doig River and Blueberry River First Nations.
